

2024 Senior Minor Post-Season Commitment Form

Being chosen to a Little League post-season team is a distinct honor and privilege as well as a responsibility. Although there may be many individuals who desire to play postseason, players selected demonstrate superior ability and skill and also a desire to improve their level of play. To develop a competitive and representative team, parents and players must understand that there are significant time commitments and some financial commitments. For example, these expectations include:

- The ability to attend all practices and games until the All-Star season is completed. Practices and games are
 held several days per week, and games may be located outside of College Station, especially if the team
 advances beyond the district tournament.
- Participation in other activities that would conflict with practices and games should be scheduled for a time
 after tournaments to minimize conflict with All-Star activities. A player can be removed from the team at the
 discretion of the All-Star team manager (with the approval of the CSLL Board of Directors) if the player
 misses practices or games. Examples of conflicting activities include family vacations, summer athletic
 camps, other sports or activities, etc.
- There will be a small fee for the All-Star uniform. Parents could also be responsible for some expenses associated with travel, especially if the team advances beyond the District Tournament. There may also be some optional expenses such as "family" shirts, team support signs, etc.

Nine and Ten-year-olds are eligible for either the 9-10-year-old All-Star team or the 9-10-Year-Old Special Games teams. Eleven-year-olds playing in the Senior Minor division are eligible for the 11-year-old All-Star team. Practices for any of these teams could begin right after the end of the regular season. Games for the Special Games (or "B" teams) will probably start sometime around June 8, and the games for the 9-10-year-old All-Star team and the 11-year-old All-Star team will probably start around June 15. **The exact dates and locations will be set by District 33 personnel and the league presidents.** These tournaments are typically double elimination, and the winner of the District 33 Special Games tournament will not advance beyond district play. The All-Star teams could advance to a Sectional tournament and a State tournament.

By signing below, I am indicating that my child and I realize that there is a time and financial commitment beyond the regular season, and permitting for my child to be considered for postseason selection. We understand that, if we fail to participate as expected, it may impact participation level during tournament play.
