

## 2024 Post-Season Manager/Coach Commitment Form

Managers and Coaches<sup>1</sup> of College Station Little League (CSLL) post-season teams should not only be representative of the values of character, courage, and loyalty synonymous with Little League, but also understand the importance of positively supporting all managers, coaches, and players in teaching all children to play fair and to do their best (as indicated in the Volunteer Pledge). All managers must also complete the Little League® Diamond Leader Training per Little League rules. If you have completed the Diamond Training in the past you are not required to complete it again.

Managers and Coaches must also understand that there are significant time commitments to develop a competitive and representative team. Most practices are held every day, and during tournament play, there could be one or two games per day. Participation in other activities that would conflict with practice and games must be scheduled after tournament play.

By signing below, I verify that I have submitted a 2024 Little League Volunteer Form to CSLL and the Diamond Leader Training certificate. Failure not to turn in the Diamond Leader Training Certificate (if applicable) with this form will result in not being considered for Postseason Manager/Coach. I understand that as a coach it is expected that my conduct and mannerism on and off the field of play in the presence of parents and players will be indicative of the highest moral and ethical character. I understand that if I have failed to represent the principles of a Little League Volunteer during the regular season, I will not be allowed to manage or coach on a CSLL All-Star team. My signature also indicates that I have read and agree to abide by the rules and regulations in the CSLL All-Star manual. Should I be selected as an All-Star Manager or Coach, I will abide by all rules and regulations set forth by CSLL and the Little League organization.
